Standard Product Codes for Billing and Reporting: Later this month, FISD will coordinate an exploratory call to discuss the desirability and feasibility of creating standardized codes for data products and delivery services. These codes would be used across the industry as part of the reporting, billing, and inventory management processes within exchanges, data vendors, and consumers.
