Robert Reich to Keynote at World Financial Information Conference

Top global financial information leaders to tackle industry issues and priorities

Washington, D.C. (June 16, 2011) - The Financial Information Services Division (FISD) of the Software & Information Industry Association (SIIA) today announced that Robert Reich, Chancellor's Professor of Public Policy at the Goldman School of Public Policy - University of California at Berkeley, will be the opening keynote for its 10th Biennial World Financial Information Services Conference (WFIC), slated for October 9-12, in San Francisco, CA.

As one of the nation's leading experts on work and the economy, Reich is well-suited to kick off WFIC. He has served in three national administrations, most recently as Secretary of Labor under President Bill Clinton. *Time Magazine* named him one of the ten most effective Cabinet secretaries of the last century.

His outspoken, realist outlook reaches millions of people each week through his syndicated columns, television appearances, and public radio commentaries. Last week, Reich made waves with his predictions about a looming "double-dip" recession--which preceded the week's alarming news about jobs and Wall Street.

Morgan Worldwide Securities Services and FISD Executive Committee Chair, "Robert Reich's expertise, industry knowledge and global perspective will be a perfect fit for the 2011 WFIC conference. He is someone who will help set the tone for a stimulating and valuable conference." The topics and discussions encompass the global issues facing the financial information industry.
